Captain John C. Compton, USN**

Captain Compton is a native of Boise, Idaho who enlisted in the Navy in 1985. He served aboard the USS Kirk (FF 1087) and the USS Constellation (CV 64) as an Electrician's Mate. Following graduation from Villanova University in 1994, he earned his Naval Aviator wings in 1997. He has logged more than 2,500 hours in the UH-3H/VH-3A and MH-60S helicopters. Sea duties include Command of Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron TWENTY FIVE (HSC-25) in Guam, Air Boss on USS Austin (LPD 4) and Squadron tours in Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron TWO (HSC-2) and Helicopter Combat Support Squadron TWO (HC-2) in Norfolk, VA.. Shore duties include command of Navy Support Facility Diego Garcia and since May 2021 command of the Naval ROTC Unit at South Carolina. He is honored today for his invaluable and outstanding service to our community, state, and nation.
